## Persian lime / Tahiti lime

Scientific name: Citrus Latifolia Tanaka.

**Description:** Seedless and semi-acid lime, its color is quite green although it yellows as it reaches full ripeness. Persian lime is thicker-skinned and less aromatic than key lime / mexican lime.

Packaging: 40 lb box / 10 lb box.

**Temperature:** 45° - 50° F.

Sizes: 40lb box 110's 150's 175's 200's 230's 10lb box 36's 42's 48's 54's 60's

**Growing season:** All year round, increasing production between march and september.

**Shelf life:** 20-24 days approximately if stored at ideal temperatures and 18-20 days in high season.

**Production zones:** Jalisco, Mexico.

# Hass avocado

Scientific name: Persea americana.

**Description:** Large sized fruit with dark green colored, it turns dark purplish-black when it ripens and yields to gentle pressure and it contains a single seed. Avocados contribute unsaturated "good" fats, and good fats can help the body absorb fat-soluble nutrients Vitamins A, D, K, and E.

**Packaging:** Depends on the customer.

Temperature: 40-45° F.

**Sizes:** Depends on the size of the box.
