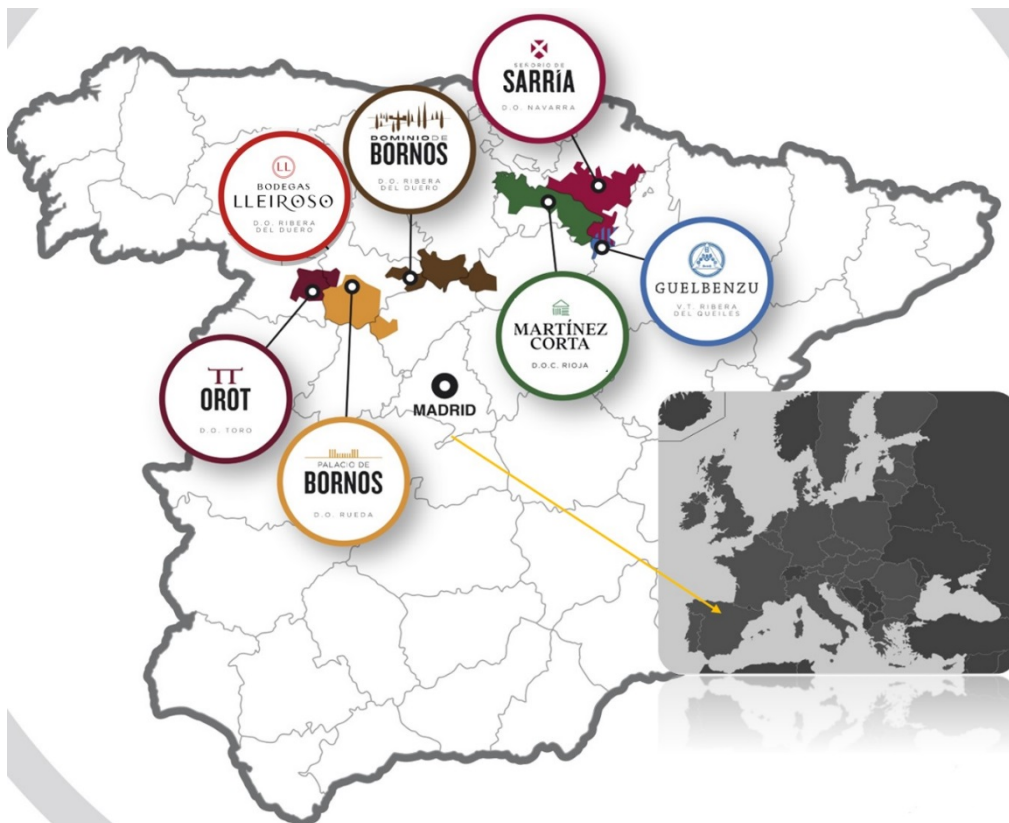

AREA – D.O. RUEDA

The Appellation of Origin **Rueda** is located in Castilla y Leon and is made up of 72 municipalities, which are located in the south of the province of Valladolid, west of Segovia and north of Ávila.



The character of the appellation is defined by three elements that result in high quality differentiated wines, with a strong personality:

- *Grape Variety:* **Verdejo, indigenous to the area**, resulting in crisp, pleasant and highly harmonious wines that invite you to continue drinking.
- *Climate:* continental with low rainfall, marked temperature contrasts between day and night and spring frosts, providing low yields and high quality.
- *Soils:* gravelly, permitting great ventilation and drainage.

The grape varieties allowed are: Verdejo, Sauvignon Blanc, Viura, Palomino Fino, Tempranillo, Garnacha, Cabernet Sauvignon and Merlot.

Located in Rueda, our winery was founded and began making wine in 1976, alongside the Appellation of Origin Rueda. And a clear commitment to the **native Verdejo** variety. The initial years were dedicated to consolidate the brand in the Castilla y Leon region, to later begin a rapid expansion both nationally and internationally. After more than forty years of solid work, successive business expansion and innovation continues,

VINEYARDS

Palacio de Bornos have 308 hectares of their **own vineyards**, of Verdejo, Sauvignon Blanc, Viura and Tempranillo, in the towns of Rueda, Pollos and La Seca.



When choosing a plot, the quality of the soil always takes precedence, with several analysis and soil samples being carried out to ascertain in detail its structure, thus ensuring that the vine will develop in the most appropriate soil. The soil of our vineyards is characterized by a calcareous clay subsoil and gravelly top soil, with a high

concentration of pebbles, allowing for good aeration and drainage, ideal characteristics for the successful development of the vine.

The special commitment to the vineyard have led Palacios Bornos to develop continuous research projects - mainly in the field of clonal selection, vine spacing, rootstock and foliar nutrition - through studies at experimental estates.



The **aim** has always been, to plant the best vines in the best soil, in order to obtain the best wines.

100% Verdejo.

Pale yellow colour with green hints. Intense floral aroma. Crisp acidity with fruity notes on the palate.



Palacio de Bornos Sauvignon Blanc

100% Sauvignon Blanc.

Bright pale yellow colour. Intense varietal aromas, with hints of tropical fruit and flowers. Fresh, tasty and well balanced.



Palacio de Bornos Verdejo La Caprichosa.

100% Verdejo

From an old vineyard, bush vines in low fertile pebbly soil. Long pre-fermentation maceration, slow fermentation and a few months stay on the lees.

Bright straw yellow colour, with green glints. Intense and complex aroma, with notes of ripe white fruit and mineral hints. Fresh and generous in the mouth, with volume, fine elegant and lingering finish.

100% Verdejo

Fermented and aged for three months in oak barrels. Golden yellow colour with green glints. Vanilla and smoked aromas, intermixed with ripe fruit notes. Round, with a good backbone on the palate.

100% Sauvignon Blanc.

Attractive pale straw-yellow colour, very clean and bright. Powerful aromas of bay leaf and tropical fruit notes on a honey background. Fresh, fruity and creamy on the palate, with perfect balance between sugar and acidity.

One-year aging in bottle.

Pale-yellow with green glints. Well-integrated fine bubbles. Intense nose with hints of mint and ripe apple. Nice palate with excellent balance between sweetness and acidity.

Two-year aging in bottle.

Straw-yellow with golden glints. Fine rounded and well-integrated bubbles. Powerful, complex and ripe aroma with white flowers and wild herbs hints. Mouth-filling and fresh on the palate, with great backbone.

100% Verdejo.

Three-year aging in bottle.

Straw-yellow with green glints. Constant and continuous release of small spherical bubbles. Highly intense nose, with tight integration between the primary aromas (ripe grapes) and the derivatives of the second fermentation (almonds, peanuts). Rounded mouth, with excellent backbone.

Nine months ageing in bottle.

Strawberry pink with light purple glints. Fine, well integrated bubbles. Intensely aromatic with floral and red berry fruit hints. Fresh and pleasant on the palate with nicely balanced acidity.

Bornos Frizzante Verdejo 5,5 °

100% Verdejo.

Fermenting at low temperature to achieve an optimum balance between sweetness and acidity.

With a pale yellow colour displaying green glints and a nose that reveals citrus and tropical fruit notes, this wine is an excellent pairing for appetizers, tapas and pastries during parties and celebrations as well as to accompany good conversation. It combines a light touch of alcohol (5,5º), which brings vivacity, with a delicate natural fizz, that lifts the spirits and fines the imagination.

AREA - D.O. NAVARRA

One of the main characteristics that define the Navarra Appellation of Origin is the great **diversity** of landscapes and climates that occur within the 100 kilometres that separate the northern area, located in the vicinity of Pamplona, from the south, located on the banks of the Ebro.

And particularly it is Navarra where this exceptional situation is produced, virtually unique in the Iberian Peninsula, the confluence of the Atlantic, Continental and Mediterranean climates. The proximity of the Cantabrian Sea, the influence of the Pyrenees and the prosperity of the Ebro valley provide this varied climate. Circumstances that leave a profound mark on the Navarre landscape, where more than 17,000 hectares of the Appellation of Origin are based on all types of ecosystems and exploitation situations: slopes, river banks, plateaus, plains, making way for five different production areas: Baja Montaña, Valdizarbe, Tierra Estella, Ribera Alta and Ribera Baja.



The permitted **grape varieties** are: Tempranillo, Garnacha, Graciano, Mazuelo, Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Pinot Noir, Syrah, Viura, Garnacha Blanca, Malvasia, Moscatel Grano



Menudo, Chardonnay and Sauvignon Blanc.





WINERY

Although the winery was founded in 1953, history shows that this land has been used for cultivating vines for many centuries. Mention of the Señorío de Sarría was made as far back as the **Middle Ages**, when in a chronicle of that era, it was stated that the Lord of Sarría joined up with King Sancho VII (the Strong) in the battle of Las Navas de Tolosa (1212). Many years later, during the 16th century, the history of the Lordship and Navarra became even more intertwined when the then Lord of Sarría (Juan de Azpilicueta), the brother of Saint Francisco Javier (the present patron saint of Navarra), paid for his studies in Paris with the income received from the livestock and crop farming of the estate. The manuscript in which Saint Francisco Javier thanked his brother for this aid is still kept today.



And it was only many years later that, in 1953, the renowned Navarre businessman, Don Félix Huarte bought the Señorío and undertook the planting of new vineyards and built the winery, where wines under the label of Señorío de Sarría were subsequently vinified and released onto the market.





Years later, in 1981, the winery separated from the Huarte family and set off on a new phase in its history, which was given special impetus in 2001 when a new ambitious project was set up to renovate the wine-making facilities and the vineyard, and thereby establish this wine estate at the forefront of the domestic and international markets.



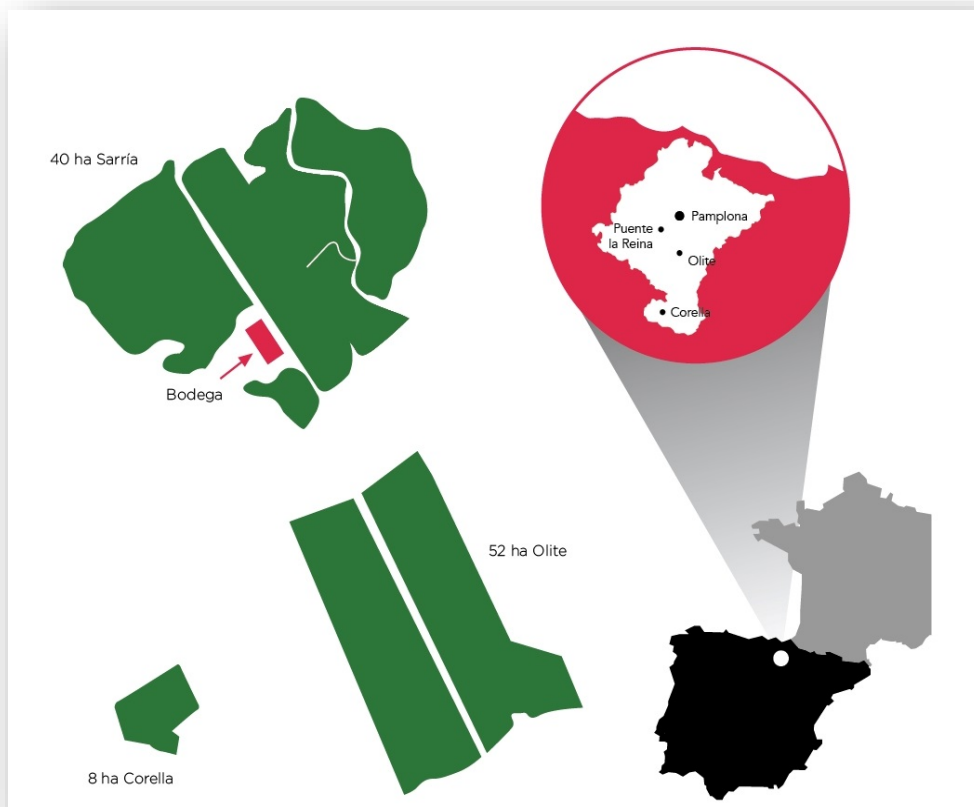
Located in **Puente la Reina**, at the heart of the pilgrims' route to Santiago, Señorío de Sarría finds itself in an area that offers excellent climate and soil conditions, enabling a range of top quality wines to be made.

We have French oak and American oak barrels, with a capacity of 225 litres each. In addition, we have a modern **tasting area** to taste and enjoy the views of our vineyards.



VINEYARDS

100 hectares of numerous varieties of vines are spread out on the slopes and sun-facing sides of Puente la Reina, Olite and Corella.



Each plant, each vineyard, each plot receives exquisite care and special monitoring to make great wines from the outset. Each grape variety has been carefully selected and cultivated in the most appropriate place, taking into account the light, humidity and temperature conditions required in each case.

The **age of vines** guarantees the excellent quality of the grapes:

- More than 60 years: Garnacha, Graciano, Tempranillo and Mazuelo.
- More than 25 years: Chardonnay.
- More than 10 years: Cabernet Sauvignon and Moscatel de Grano Menudo

100% Chardonnay. Straw-yellow colour, with green hues. Powerful fruity nose, with hints of white flowers and exotic fruits. Fresh and balanced, with excellent acidity.



Señorío de Sarría Rosado

100% Garnacha. Raspberry red colour. Intense and fruity aroma, with red fruits and fennel notes. Pleasant and fresh on the palate, with lingering fruit.



Señorío de Sarría Rosé

Garnacha & Graciano. Lavender-pink colour, clean and bright. Fresh with red berry fruit aromas (raspberries), grapefruit, lychees together with sweet notes of jellybeans against an attractive rose petal backdrop. Fresh and fruity on the palate, flavoursome with a log vibrant finish.

100% Garnacha. Aged for three months in American oak barrels. Intense cherry red colour with violet rim. Aromas of black and red fruit, with mineral, spicy and toasty oak notes. Good backbone on the palate, with a well-balanced, round feeling. Fruit, pepper, and roasted notes.



Señorío de Sarría Crianza

Cabernet Sauvignon /Garnacha/Graciano. Aged for one year in American oak barrels. Dark cherry red colour. Aroma of red fruits on a background of vanilla, with toasty oak and balsamic notes. Good fruity expression on the palate, with balanced acidity and good finish.



Señorío de Sarría Reserva

Cabernet Sauvignon/ Graciano. Aged for two years in French and American oak barrels. Dark red cherry colour. Intense toasty and spicy aromas, with hints of vanilla and cinnamon. Powerful, tasty, structured, complex palate, with well-integrated wood.



Señorío de Sarría Gran Reserva

Merlot / Cabernet Sauvignon. Aged for three years in French and American oak barrels. Deep red colour. Intense spicy and balsamic aromas. Tasty and complex on the palate, with notes of cream, prune, caramel and black fruit. Well integrated oak.



Señorío de Sarría Moscatel Grano Menudo

100% Moscatel Grano Menudo. Straw-yellow. Intense nose, sweet, with notes of white flowers, acacia, honey and lemon peel. Intense, tasty attack. Excellent acidity compensated with a balanced sweetness.

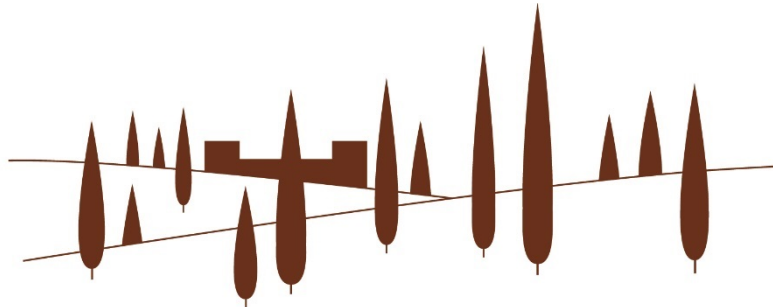

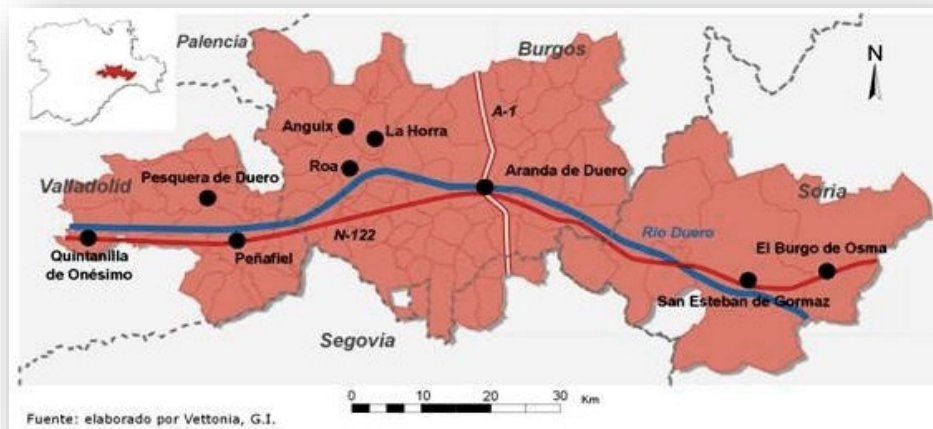

AREA – RIBERA DEL DUERO

The lands which are grouped under the Appellation of Origin Ribera del Duero are located at the confluence of four provinces of Castilla y León: Burgos, Segovia, Soria and Valladolid, where the Duero River is the axis linking the different localities within the Appellation.



The climate is characterized by low average rainfall, coupled with hot dry summers and long, cold winters, classifying it within a continental Mediterranean climate. These weather conditions have a crucial role in the correct plant development and ripening of the grapes.

The soil is composed of sandy and clay sediments, emphasizing the alternating layers, both of limestone, and marl.



The grape **varieties** permitted are:

- Red: Tempranillo, Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Malbec, Garnacha and
- White: Albillo.

WINERY

The winery is located in the “Golden Mile” of the Ribera del Duero, Valbuena del Duero, Valladolid, Spain, nestled at an altitude of 780 meters.

The grape variety we use is Tempranillo, also known as Tinta fina or Tinta del país. Our grapes are grown in vineyards which are 25 to 80 years old, well rooted in privileged soils.



The soils of the region are in an alluvial area, are clayey-calcareous with brown-grey streaks.

The climatology is characterized by moderate to low rainfall, dry summers with temperatures up to 40°C, and long harsh winters, with temperatures reaching -18°C. The climate is a mixture between Continental and Mediterranean, with more than 2,400 hours of sun.



VINEYARDS

We carry out an exhaustive control in the selection of the best grapes and our suppliers, with whom we collaborate closely all year long to produce first-class wine.

The grapes we use come from our 25 hectares in **Valbuena del Duero, Pesquera de Duero** and from the highlands of the Ribera Burgalesa.

The main objective of this innovative wine is the production and ageing of first-class wine to satisfy the demands of our clients and the best wines tasters.



Our grapes are handpicked in crates with a capacity no greater than 15 kg to ensure their integrity. Bunches go through the sorting table, they are singled out with the destemmer and then the whole grape is passed on to the deposit.

We use cutting-edge technology in the enology field: truncated-conical stainless steel vats with cooling jackets, cold units and pneumatic press.

The fermentation time varies from eight to 20 days, at a temperature between 25°C and 28°C. It is followed by the malolactic fermentation.

Each one of our wines will age the necessary time in French and American oak barrels in order to obtain the best result possible.

At the beginning of the year, after a couple of months in tanks, the wine is transferred to French and American oak barrels. Ageing time depends on the labels being produced and on the quality of the harvest. It goes from six to 24 months.

The barrel cellar contains around 500 barrels: 75% of them French oak and 25% of them American oak. The French oaks are of fine grain from Allier, and the American oaks are from Missouri. As a result of oak selection and controls during the ageing process, we produce complex, elegant and powerful wines full of nuances.

HISTORY

In 2001, Mr. Alberto Cobo, a pharmacist native to Jaén but settled in Valladolid, decided to pursue his passion for wine and create a winery in which he could produce and age first-class wine.

That was the point of innovative Bodegas y Viñedos Lleiroso, located in the so called “Golden Mile” of the Ribera del Duero, a few meters away from the river that nourishes its vineyard. Since its first days, Bodegas Lleiroso proved to be internationally oriented as it exported its first wines to Europe and Mexico.

The destinations to of our exportations have increased as time has passed, to the United States of America and China.



The winery immediately showed passionate determination to create first-class wine. The reward to such effort arrived with the produce of the first harvest: our emblematic wine Lleiroso LL Signature Wine 2002, was awarded the Golden Tempranillo at the 2005 Tempranillos al Mundo competition held in Copenhagen.

Many others have followed this first prize, year after year, demonstrating the high quality of all our wines. We are a family-owned winery that guarantees seriousness, quality and continuity in time.

In a world controlled by colossal multinationals, we firmly believe that an independent producer, in order to see his own enterprise thrive, must produce the highest quality possible and target those sophisticated consumers that aspire to be a superior lifestyle. This is why we tend to our wines even before they come into existence, because great wines start in the vineyard and conclude in the winery”.

Aged for four to six months in American and French oak barrels. Intense red with violet undertones, medium layer. Primary characters of the varietal used come through, such as blackcurrant and red fruits, which is perfectly assembled with hints of spices, cinnamon and vanilla from the oak wood barrels. Freshy, ample, well-balanced with soft texture, with a long finish and after taste.

LLEIROSO CRIANZA

100% Tinta Fina(Tempranillo)

Aged for 12 months in French oak barrels and another 12 months in the bottle. Ruby red with topaz, well-covered, clear and brilliant reflections. Well-developed aromatic potential, perfect blend of fruit, wood, spices, balsamic and toasted aromas. Voluminous, round, velvety, balanced, with a long after taste.

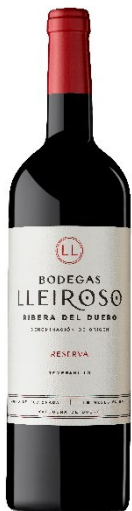

Aged for 15 months in French oak barrels and another 24 months in the bottle.

Ruby red with a red trim, high layer, clear and brilliant. Intense, toasted oak and ripe red fruit well integrated with the oak. Licorise, balsamic, spice aroma and mineral notes. Voluminous, well-balanced, round and smooth. A long finish.

WINERY

Located in **Pesquera de Duero**, the winery was founded in 1988 with the intention of maximizing the great potential which the area had already demonstrated thanks to the quality of the land and its climate.

The winery focuses towards making small and selected productions of wine. It has some carefully designed, modern facilities for wine-making, as well as a barrel cellar with American and French oak barrels for the aging of the two wines of the range in the Dominio de Bornos: Roble and Crianza.



VINEYARDS

The vineyards are grouped under the Appellation of Origen Ribera de Duero. Dominio de Bornos has collaborative agreements with vine-growers in the area, with our technical department carrying out a thorough control throughout the vine development process, choosing the most appropriate sites and selecting the best grapes for the production of our range of wines.

Dominio de Bornos Roble

100% Tempranillo.

Aged for six months in American and French oak casks. Cherry red colour with violet rim. Intense on the nose, with fresh red berry fruit aromas and toasted notes from the oak. Elegant with well integrated wood. Tasty and silky on the palate.



Dominio de Bornos Crianza

100% Tempranillo.

Aged for one year in French oak casks. Cherry red with violet rim. Great aromatic potential with hints of toasted aromas, vanilla, cocoa and wild red berry fruits, combining in great harmony. Elegant, with great backbone on the palate.



MARTÍNEZ CORTA

D.O.C. RIOJA

AREA – D.O.Ca. RIOJA

The production area of the Denomination of Origin Calificada D.O.Ca. Rioja is distributed in the territory of the three riverside provinces of the upper Ebro river: La Rioja, Álava and Navarra.

The whole area benefits from the confluence of two distinctly opposed climates -Atlantic and Mediterranean- which provide mild temperatures and an annual rainfall of slightly above 400 l/m² -ideal conditions for grape growing.



The grape **varieties** that are currently authorised by the Regulations of the D. O. Ca. Rioja are:

- Red: tempranillo, garnacha, graciano, mazuelo and maturana tinta.
- White: viura, malvasía, garnacha blanca, tempranillo blanco, maturana blanca, turruntés, chardonnay, sauvignon blanc and verdejo.

In order to optimize wine quality, the Regulations of the D.O.Ca. Rioja set maximum allowable yields which are 6,500 kilograms per hectare for red grape varieties and 9,000 kg/ha for white grape varieties. The wine region's annual production currently stands at 280 to 300 million liters, of which 90% is red, the rest being white and rosé.

WINERY

Martínez Corta, a family estate with a long history and great recognition in the area. With 80 hectares of vineyards. Based in Uruñuela, Martínez Corta is an emblematic winery located in the heart of the Rioja Alta, result of the work of a family dedicated to the world of wine during **four** generations. They were traditionally winegrowers who, not satisfied with only being producers, also wanted to transfer their wisdom and



experience to the production of quality wines with their own identity. It was the second generation, led by Félix Martínez Marijuan, who began to produce wines 50 years ago, up till 2005 when his grandchildren started building the new winery with state-of-the-art facilities, with special attention to the traditional winemaking technique.

VINEYARDS

The 80 hectares of the family owned vineyards are located in the privileged area of the Lower Najerilla Valley, bordering Cenicero, between the rivers Ebro and Najerilla, bringing a particular humidity to the environment. The vineyard's singularity combined with the topographical factors create a distinct environment, with mild winters and hot and dry summers, granting ideal ripening conditions. In addition, the southern exposure of the vineyards guarantees maximal sunshine, which combined with moderate rainfalls results in excellent climatic conditions. Besides, the poor calcareous and clayey soils, ideal for growing vines, ensure low yields and high-quality crops.

Aged for one year in American and French barrels.

AREA – RIBERA DEL QUEILES

The Ribera del Queiles IGP Area is composed of 16 municipalities, it was created in 2003 at the request of Guelbenzu and covers a stretch of 22 kilometers south of the Rio Ebro, between Navarra, Rioja and Aragon. Named after the Queiles River, a tributary which rises in Mount Moncayo and flows into the river Ebro, in the area of Tudela.

The permitted grape **varieties** are: Tempranillo, Graciano, Garnacha, Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot and Syrah.

WINERY

Guelbenzu's history goes back to 1851, when it was reported that taxes were paid in demijohns of wine sold by Don Martín María Guelbenzu.

It was his son, Miguel Guelbenzu, who modernised and developed the winery, gaining significant awards in 1880 in the form of medals and accolades which were to form an integral part of the company's image and to figure on the labels of its range of wines, as can still be seen today.

Several generations later, Don Ricardo Guelbenzu took over the reins of the winery, setting in motion a new era of growth and development, which began in 1992 with the launch of what were to become the flagships of our new range of wines, Guelbenzu Evo and Azul. The range was completed in 1999 with the addition of the winery's iconic brand, Guelbenzu Lautus.

Evo means "duration of eternal things", and with this name we sought to mirror this wine's ability to age and improve over time. The name Lautus refers to "laureate" or "award-winning", and was attributed to convey the renown that this wine was expected to achieve in its future.



At a later date, in 2010, the winery took on a new challenge, when it inaugurated its new wine-making facilities in Vierlas (an area along the border between Aragon and Navarra), in the locality of Lombana, where new brands linked to this new location were then launched.

The prevailing concept during the construction of the winery was respect for the environment, optimizing space and fostering optimal conditions for temperature controlled storage, having managed to obtain facilities that are perfectly integrated into the landscape and vineyards and, at the same time, are excellent for the making and aging of Guelbenzu wine.

VINEYARDS

Guelbenzu has **46 hectares of vineyard** located in **Vierlas**, right in the heart of the Queiles valley, on the Lombana estate.



The Lombana is an elongated estate made up of materials from the tertiary period, and more than 22.5 million years old. The stony, infertile ground is extraordinary for growing grapes due to its texture, drainage, low yields, resistance to drought and low risk of frost.

The proximity of Mount Moncayo causes the temperature fluctuations between day and night to be very high, which contributes positively to the formation of tannins and anthocyanins, essential for the production of round wines with body, character and aging ability.

In addition, the north wind which blows through the area, is a constant strong, dry, cold wind with significant drying capacity, which favours evaporation and prevents the formation of fogs and moisture.

Guelbenzu Vierlas

80% *Merlot* 20% *Syrah* varieties.

Aged for six months in French and American oak barrels.

Deep cherry colour. Intense on the nose, with floral notes mixed with cedar and cream. Expressive in the mouth, with well integrated tannins and a toasted aftertaste.



Guelbenzu Azul

Structured around the *Tempranillo* variety.

Aged for nine months in French and American oak barrels.

Deep red cherry colour. Complex nose with notes of red fruit, spices and plums. Full-bodied, good backbone and lingering palate, with well integrated wood.



Guelbenzu Evo

Structured around the *Cabernet Sauvignon* variety.

Aged for twelve months in French oak barrels.

Brilliant deep cherry red wine. Aromas of black fruits, with hints of minerals and toasted aromas. Powerful in the mouth, elegant, fleshy and balanced.



Guelbenzu Lombana

Structured around the *Graciano* variety.

Aged for twelve months in French and American oak barrels.

Deep garnet-red colour with purple glints. Fine and intense nose, with aromas of black fruits and woody notes. Powerful attack, followed by a silky mid-palate and a lingering finish.

AREA – D.O. TORO

The Appellation of Origin TGoldis located in Castilla y León, southeast of the province of Zamora, with an area of 5,500 hectares of vineyards.



The arid character of the area is characterized by an extreme continental climate with **Atlantic** influences. The cold winters and long hours of sunshine are excellent conditions for the successful development of the grape.

The soil, composed of sandstone, clay and limestone is ideal for the cultivation of native varieties.

The permitted grape **varieties** are:

- Red: Tinta de Toro, Garnacha,
- White: Verdejo and Malvasia.





WINERY

The origins of Orot (Toresanas) dates back to 1980, although it was in 1997, envisioning the development and possibilities of the TGold D.O., when we decided to build a winery of our own in the **town of Toro**, in the heart of the Appellation.



The two-floor building, one of which is buried underground, boasts an excellent crianza room maintained naturally at optimal temperature and humidity conditions, favouring the aging of our wines

VINEYARDS

Toresanas has 20 hectares of their own vineyards with the **Tinta de TGold** variety, which is more than 15 years old. Located southeast of the province of Zamora, it is situated at an altitude of 700 meters above sea level. The clay and sandstone terrain and limestone sediments, is ideal for growing this grape variety, which benefits greatly from soils which are lacking in organic matter, calcareous and with low levels of humidity.

Intense red with deep colour, blue and purple glints. Marked fruity nose with floral notes. Fresh, lively and balanced on the palate.



Orot Roble

100% Tinta de Toro.

Grapes come from old bush vines, picked by hand and sorted on a sorting table before the entrance into the vat cellar. Aged for **six months** in American and French oak barrels. Cherry red, clean and extremely lively. Aromas of red fruits and spices, with hints of licorice. Good backbone on the palate, fleshy, fresh and markedly fruity.



Orot Crianza

100% Tinta de Toro.

Grapes coming from old bush vines, picked by hand and sorted on a sorting table before the entrance into the vat cellar.

Aged for **one year** in French and American oak barrels.

Garnet cherry, with deep colour. Elegant and highly intense aromas, with fruity, mineral and spicy character. Powerful and fleshy palate, with clear notes of ripe fruit.
